Dr. Parul Dua Makkar completed her Bachelor of Science from the University of Central Oklahoma in 1999, Magna Cum Laude, and then attained her DDS from the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry in 2003. She believes oral care is the gateway to overall wellbeing and aims to have open conversations with her patients.
